





We approach another winter. Ensure you take care of your health. Those eligible for immunisations like the Influenza (Flu) and RSV would have heard from the practice and have appointments. Please contact the practice if you haven't heard and are eligible. The practice is only delivering the Covid vaccination to care home and housebound patients.

This month, I focus on communication between the hospital, the practice and patients. Many departments do copy the letter to the GP to you, the patient. This is essential, as it is a summary of the consultation in hospital and it allows you to go over it again in your own time. For us in the practice, it is extremely helpful especially if medication changes have been recommended. This can either be addition of a new medication, cessation of a medication or a dose reduction or increase in medication. If you do not hear from the practice within 2-3 weeks of your hospital appointment, please contact the practice through Reception or Dispensary.

In most cases the practice receives the letter in time, but occasionally there can be a delay in the appropriate clinician acting on the information either at the hospital or at the practice, due to various reasons like staff illness, shortage of staff and annual leave. The practice wants to ensure efficient and safe care and is working constantly on trying to improve services. One of the ways would be for you to contact us after a reasonable period which is usually 2 – 3 weeks after a hospital appointment. Please do not run out of your new or adjusted medication before contacting us.

Let us work together to look after your health and to help us practice in a satisfying and productive way.

Thought for the month...


'No man is an Island'

There are 15 people in a rugby team, two in a tennis doubles team and in all these teams

it is the range of aptitudes and personalities that makes it work.



An orchestra is another kind of team and it is clearly apparent that the different instruments are individual in shape and have distinct functions which all work together to provide a harmonious result.

In everyday life it is this blend of personalities and talents that enriches us.

As your mother or possibly grandmother may have said:

'Two heads are better than one'.

We have a lot of teams that we operate in, though we may not call them that.

There are family teams, school teams, neighbourly teams and little teams of friendship groups, the people we meet occasionally for lunch, the ones we meet by chance walking the dog.

If a clod be washed away by the sea,


Europe is the less,



The Hempnall Group: news about clergy

1. New posts

We're pleased to share the news that we shall be able to advertise before long for two clergy posts, to serve across both the Hempnall Group of Parishes and the adjoining Brooke Benefice. both of which have been in clergy vacancy since the spring.

Following recent consideration by the Bishops of Thetford and Norwich, by all our

Following recent consideration by the Bishops of Thetford and Norwich, by all our Parochial Church Councils and by our Joint Council, the plans are as follows:

- Each benefice the Hempnall Group and the Brooke Benefice will remain legally independent. (We won't be joining into one new, combined benefice). So we shall each retain our own governance structures as now.
- The two benefices will be linked through the appointment of two priests in common, each working across both benefices.
- One post will be full-time, with the appointee becoming Rector (or Priest-in-Charge) in both benefices.
- The other post will be part-time (to be what is called a 'House for Duty'
 appointment and equating to a half-time position), to serve as 'Team
 Minister' [exact title to be decided] in both benefices.
- Both posts will be advertised together.
- One postholder will live in the present Hempnall Rectory and the other in the current Brooke Vicarage, respective locations to be decided at time of appointment.
- Our two benefices will share between them the resources and the costs of the above package with its c.1.5 fte (full-time equivalent) clergy.
- The Ministry Team as a whole including Licensed Lay Ministers (LLMs) and Authorised Worship Assistants (AWAs) – will be in common, working together as at present.

Importantly, this structure preserves the identity of each benefice while offering, through pooling resources, the advantages of having a clergy team.

Work is now underway to prepare the necessary 'profiles' and other documentation needed for advertisement etc and we shall be consulting PCCs on this in the coming weeks. Nationally, it's not easy to recruit clergy at the moment but we hope and pray that suitable candidates will come forward. We'll report further in due course.

The commissioning / licensing service will be conducted by Bishop Ian of Thetford in **Hempnall Church** on **Monday 7th October at 7pm** and **all are warmly invited to attend.** There will be refreshments.

Many will recall that Michael was a Curate in the Hempnall Group in the 1990s and he has been a resident in one of our parishes for many years. In his role as Rural Dean he will be supporting ministry in benefices across a wide area (from Brooke to Mulbarton, including Long Stratton).

During our vacancy Michael and several other local clergy have kindly been assisting with provision of Holy Communion services, funerals, weddings, baptisms etc, while our lay ministry team lead a variety of other services. Those existing arrangements will continue while we seek to put in place the intended new package, as described above.
